

**AGREEMENT OF PARTICIPATION
APTA CREDENTIALLED CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR PROGRAM – LEVEL 1**

The *Level 1 Credentialed Clinical Instructor Program* is being offered by the *University of Utah, Department of Physical Therapy and Athletic Training*. Successful completion of the program and its Assessment Center for physical therapists and physical therapist assistants will result in the awarding of Level 1 Clinical Instructor Credentialing and 1.6 CEU/16 contact hours* (please note difference if from OH or NV) from the American Physical Therapy Association. Other health care providers will receive 1.2 CEU/12 contact hours*.

**Please note: Licensees should verify with their [state licensing board](#) for acceptance of continuing education units by reviewing the relevant state practice act and/or administrative code.*

To be eligible for Level 1 credentialing, the participant must:

1. Submit prior to the course registration deadline:
 - a. An *electronically (or typed), fully completed CCIP Level 1 Participant Dossier*,
 - b. A *signed Agreement of Participation*, and
 - c. A *current copy of your professional license*.
2. Attend each session of the program in its entirety and participate in all program activities.
3. Successfully complete each portion of the Assessment Center if a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant.

NOTE:

If any part of the program is missed, the participant must repeat the entire program to be eligible for Level 1 CI Credentialing.

Only participants who have completed all program sessions will be permitted to sit for the Assessment Center when completing this program (physical therapists and physical therapist assistants only).

A participant who does not satisfactorily complete the Assessment Center or fails to attend the entire didactic curriculum as part of the program will be notified by the Credentialed Clinical Trainer that he/she has not met the competencies required and is not being recommended for APTA Level 1 Clinical Instructor credentialing.

Should a participant need to request a refund, he or she must do so within 72 hours prior to the date of the beginning of the course. The refund amount will be equivalent to the APTA portion of the registration fee only.
