

International Student Application Policy

This policy is related to potential Master of Athletic Training students who received their bachelor's degree or equivalent at a college or university outside of the United States. Our policy and procedures are to match the University of Utah Graduate School International Student policies. Application Process

The first step is to apply to the University of Utah Master of Athletic Training through the Athletic Training Central Application System (ATCAS) and follow the program's application process. This information can be found on the MAT program Application [website](#).

If selected for admissions to the Master Athletic Training program, you will then apply the Graduate School at the University of Utah. The Office of International Admissions will determine if international degree requirements meet the Graduate School's requirements.

Prerequisite Courses

Our prerequisite courses are required to make sure you are prepared for our graduate-level curriculum. These topics are also external accreditation requirements set by the Commission on Accreditation of Athletic Training Education ([CAATE](#)).

- For international students, we realize your degree or course types may be different than at a United States institution. All international student transcripts and documentation will be reviewed by a faculty committee to determine if the prerequisite topics are met. It will be the applicant's responsibility to provide sufficient documentation that explains their international coursework that fulfill the prerequisite course content. Official English translations must be provided if the transcripts are only in the native language.
- It is important to submit your application early so we can properly review the prerequisite information. We may ask for additional information. We encourage international students to apply prior to December 15.
 - If the faculty committee determines some of the prerequisites are not met by your previous degree requirements, you will be asked to complete those courses while at the University of Utah within the first 2 semesters of the Master Athletic Training program.
 - You can only complete 3 prerequisite courses after being enrolled in the Master of Athletic Training program at the University of Utah. If you are missing more than 3 of the prerequisite topics, you will not be admitted to the Master of Athletic Training program.
