SPEECH AND HEARING SCIENCE (SPHS) UNDERGRADUATE MAJOR**

Graduation Checklist 2019+

SPHS majors must have a 3.0 GPA in CSD courses and a 2.5 GPA overall in order to graduate. A minimum of a “C-“ must be earned for all required core courses. All SPHS majors must also complete 25 ASHA observation hours over the course of their program of study. The University of Utah requires a minimum of 122 hours to graduate, with 40 of those hours being at a 3000 level or above. SPHS majors must complete their observation hours and take all of the 19 required courses (including 3 laboratory sections - see below). Transfer students must complete at least 5 University of Utah CSD courses at the 4000 level or higher.

III. REQUIRED LABORATORY SECTION (3 courses, 1 credit hour each): As part of the REQUIRED CORE, Students enrolled in CSD 2200, 4200, and 4400 need to be concurrently enrolled in their corresponding laboratory sections: CSD 2201, 4210, and 4401.

IV. REQUIRED DEPARTMENTAL ELECTIVES (3 credit hours minimum): As part of the REQUIRED CORE for the SPHS BA and SPHS BS degrees, each student must complete a minimum of 3 credit hours (1 course) of DEPARTMENTAL ELECTIVES. This requirement can be satisfied with any courses listed below:

1. CSD 3850 Special Topics. This course does not represent a regular departmental offering. Check in with the CSD academic advisor for updates.

2. CSD 4100 Understanding Children with Autism and their Families. This course can also count toward a Minor in Disability Studies (see link for details): <https://disabilitystudies.utah.edu/undergraduate/courses.phpcertificate>

3. CSD 4150 Communication Disorders in the Media

4. CSD 4600 Diverse Populations with Communication Needs. This course also satisfies the University of Utah's Bachelor's Degree Diversity (DV) requirement and has the Community Engaged Learning (CEL) designation.

V. ASHA OBSERVATION HOURS: 25 hours of clinical observations supervised by certified professionals must be completed prior to graduation. It is the student's responsibility to make sure that the signed observation worksheet has been placed into their file. For most students, this requirement is completed as part of their participation in CSD 5400 Clinical Methods.
